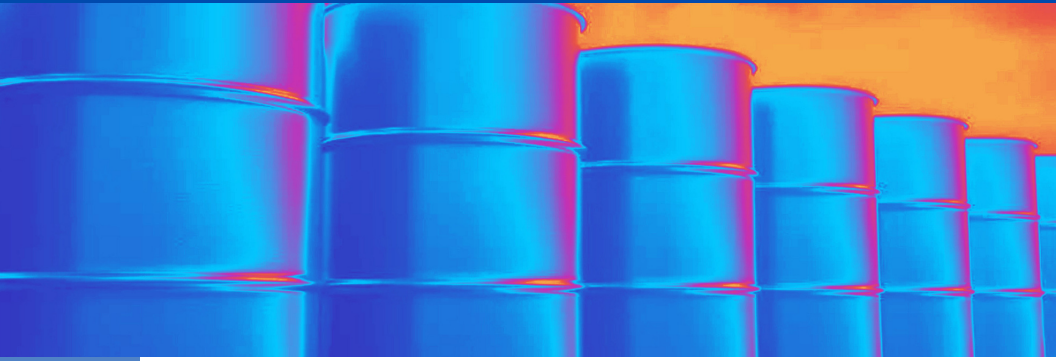


7 Ways to Beat the Lubrication Oil Supply Shortage

1 Plan well ahead of a major event need. Take your normal planning process and multiply by a factor of 3.

2 Consider oil analysis before you change out a major system. Know for sure if a complete change out is necessary.

3 Is the oil just dirty & contaminated? If so, consider filtration & oil system cleaning by FilterIT. www.filteritservices.com

4 Is "sweetening" the system an option vs. a complete change out to reduce the volume of new oil required?

5 Filter your new oil to an ISO cleanliness code & make provisions to keep it cleaner. Cleaner oil lasts longer.

6 Got leaks? If leaked oil can be captured & segregated, many times it can be cleaned at a fraction of the cost of buying new oil.

7 Do you have an "all-loss" oil system that consumes a certain amount of oil each day? Ask our Reliability Engineers for an assessment on product alternatives to this norm.
